

NEW LONDON HOSPITAL DAYS COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION INFORMATION TABLE GUIDELINES

All participants will abide by these guidelines as well as directions given by the Event Staff in the staging area.

- Event Staff retain the right to stage participants in a manner that provides for an entertaining, safe and timely fair. Event Staff and officials have the authority to remove any participant from the vendor fair who does not abide by these rules and regulations.
- All participants assume full and complete responsibility for any personal injury and/or property damage that may be sustained or caused during their entrance into the staging area, while in the staging area, or through the duration of this event. Participants will not hold New London Hospital, New London Police Department or the Town of New London liable in the event of personal injury or vendor tent or items damaged.
- While we applaud all forms of free expression, it is not intended to be a political rally. Expect the pressing of outside agendas to be frowned upon, unless deployed with humor, ingenuity, and within the creative, celebratory spirit of the event. Any persons campaigning or participating in political solicitation will be asked to leave the fair.
- Volume of amplified music must be at a reasonable level.
- No open flames are allowed. Keep in mind that the Town Green and grass surface is uneven at various locations and there are inclines and declines.
- New London Police Officers have the authority to remove any participant or static display that appears to be unsafe or poses a risk to public safety.
- Any juvenile under the age of 12 involved in this event must be properly supervised by a responsible adult.
- Participants involving animals of any kind must provide their own immediate clean-up in the staging area and the Town Green. All animals must either be on a leash or secured in a cage or container as to not run loose during the event.
- The community organization information event will take place rain or shine, however in case of thunder/lightning, start time may be moved back or the event may be canceled. Event Coordinators will do their best to reach all participants about changes. Updates will also be made via New London Hospital's Facebook page.
- The community organization information event is a public and camera-friendly event hosted by New London Hospital. Your entry's participation in or with this event constitutes implied consent to be photographed and to have those photos published on the Hospital's website, social media or promotional materials.
